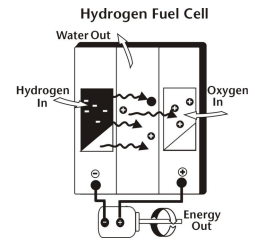


Basic Facts

- Atomic # : 1
- Atomic symbol : H
- Atomic weight : 1.0079
- Hydrogen is most basic element
- Each atom has 1 proton
- Hydrogen is what makes up the star
- Since Hydrogen doesn't exist by itself, we need to subtract them from other elements



Use of Hydrogen

- US produces huge amount of hydrogen and its amount is about 7.8 million tonnes
- Lots of industries also use hydrogen. For example, it's used in metal involving industry and food processing industry
- Electrocities are made out of hydrogen's fuel cells
- Vehicles with hydrogen started to come out currently and now there's about 200 in US
