"Why is iron Fe and Neon Ne?"

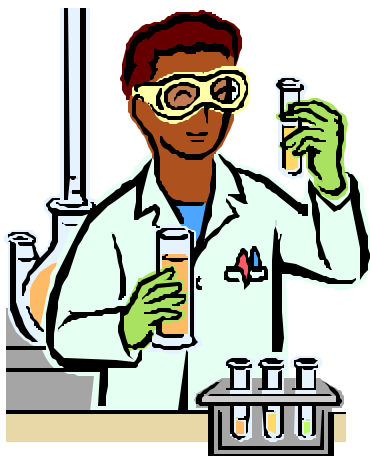
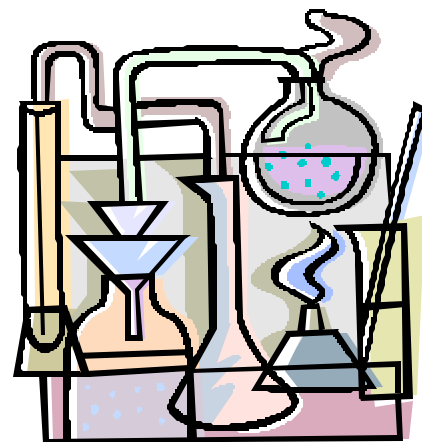
And what's with tungsten being a W an Antimony -Sb?"
