

Chemistry

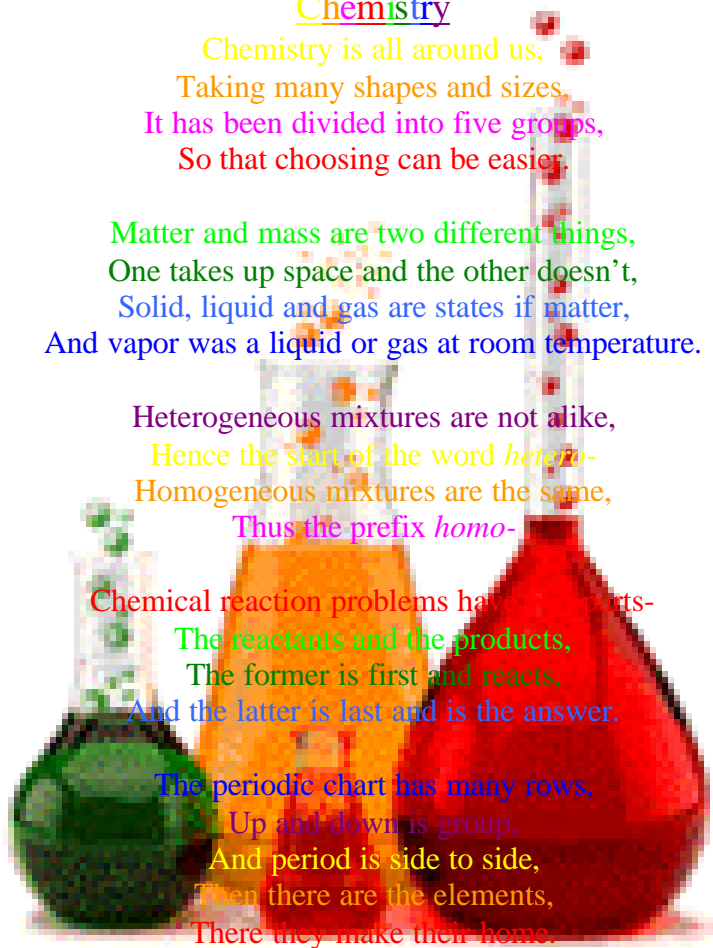
Chemistry is all around us,
